



## **Children and Family Needs Grant Recipient Expectations**

Originally formed in 1991 as Friends of Alaska CASA, Friends of Alaska's Children in Care (FACC) is a non-profit organization that raises funds to help ensure that every child and youth in State and Tribal care have the greatest possible opportunity for success. When other resources are not available, FACC support may be provided in several different ways including mini grants for children and youth's unmet needs, camperships, or educational scholarships. Support to the child or youth's family may also be provided to facilitate visitation and reunification as outlined in the grant program.

It is the expectation of FACC, and those from whom we are ever grateful to receive donations, that any and all items provided by FACC are to remain with the child/youth on whose behalf the support was awarded. If for some reason the child/youth who received support from FACC has a change in residence, we ask that the support(s) provided (such as clothing, bikes, musical instruments, sports gear, paid camp tuition, furniture) are sure to stay with the child or youth for their continued benefit. If for some reason, this is not possible, we ask that you reach out to FACC for other options so that we may ensure benefit to another child or youth in care.
