Any size completed quilt will be gratefully accepted and there are no restrictions on the theme of your quilts). Yes, you can donate more than one! Please be sure to sign and/or name your quilt(s) in the form of a label or permanent ink on its backside. Please attach a sleeve or secure with sewn-on hooks if your quilt contribution is to be used as a wall hanging. If you are contributing more than one quilt, a Data Form must accompany each item.

Completed quilts must be turned in no later than 12:00 NOON, Saturday, November 10, 2018. Drop off locations in Anchorage are Seams Like Home, The Quilt Tree and Quilt Zone; in Eagle River at The Quilt Cache and Twisted Sisters' Quilty Pleasures; in Palmer at Just Sew; and in Wasilla at Sylvia's Quilt Depot. Additionally, you may contact Debby or Becky (see front of flyer) to arrange for pick up or delivery. If necessary to mail your quilt donation, please contact Debby Hudson by phone or email listed on the front of this flyer.

A summary of the results of the quilt auction event will be mailed to each quilt contributor.
